

Garden of Remembrance

VISITOR GUIDANCE

Authorised Memorials Only

- Only officially authorised commemorative products supplied by Breckland Crematorium Ltd, such as plaques or vases, are permitted.

Visitor Conduct

- Visitors are expected to behave respectfully, refraining from disruptive behaviour.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times. There are areas of deep water within the gardens.
- Well behaved dogs are permitted in the garden of remembrance, they must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Keep dogs to marked paths to avoid fouling an area where ashes are scattered, and any waste must be picked up.

Maintenance & Grounds

- Visitors should not interfere with trees, shrubs, or other landscaping elements.
- No personal planting or decorations are permitted in garden areas.
- Items left unattended or not in compliance with the rules may be removed without notice.

Placement of Floral Tributes

- Cut flowers can be placed on or adjacent to memorials. Alternatively, artificial flowers may be used in lieu of cut flowers provided they are maintained appropriately.
- A maximum of 2 spiked plastic flower vases may be placed next to each metal memorial plaque in the scattering gardens.
- Wall and floor standing vases are available in the book of remembrance room for communal use. Any vases removed from the room will be returned by staff.
- Ceramic flowerpots, glassware, and other non-natural items are prohibited.
- Floral tributes are usually removed once they are no longer fresh, in the book of remembrance room staff will also clean the associated dry-wipe board for another visitors use.

Memorial Gardens & Seasonal Tributes

- Seasonal tributes, such as Remembrance or Christmas wreaths, are allowed but are removed from 12 days after the event.

- Tributes must be placed in designated areas; unauthorised placements may be removed without notice.

Interment & Scattering of Ashes

- Interment and scattering of ashes is permitted in designated areas, but requires prior approval and must be conducted under supervision so accurate records are maintained and licensing conditions are met.

Prohibited Items

- Personal items such as glassware, candles, ornaments, memorabilia, fencing, wirework, windmills, flags, toys, gravel/chippings, pot plants and other non-approved decorations are not allowed and may be removed without notice.
- These items can pose safety hazards and interfere with maintenance activities.
- Non-perishable items which have been removed will be retained safely for one month to be reclaimed. Unclaimed items will be sensitively and appropriately disposed of.
